Day 01: Guwahati- Kamakhya Temple- Shillong

On entering Guwahati visit Kamakhya Temple and proceed to Shillong which is also known as "Scotland of the East". Surrounded by Sylvan hills in Shillong visit majestic placid lake called Umium Lake.



Day 02: Shillong -- Jowai - Dawki- Shillong

On the second day visit to Jowai which is summer capital of the Jaintia Kings of Sutnga State. This place in Meghalaya is known for most magical Krang Suri falls and Phi Phi Water falls. Tryshi Waterfall in Jowai is surrounded with an expanse of green paddy fields. Enjoy breathtaking view of the pynthor nein of jowai from the bridge. Head towards to Laitlum Canyon and then visit Thadlaskein Lake in Meghalaya. Proceed to Nartiang Menhir which measures 27 feet height, 6 feet wide and 2.6 Feet thick and visit 500 years old Durga Temple in Nartiang.



Day 03: Shillong -Dawki - Mawlynnong - Shillong

Mawlynong is Asia's cleanest village where you see the beauty of Living root bridge of Mawlynnong. In the Dawki visit Umngot river where water is crystal clear. End your day by visiting Bangladesh border.



Day 04: Cherrapunji Sightseeing

Cheerapunji is known for heaviest rainfall destination in the world which possesses some exotic waterfalls and limestone caves in Meghalaya. Visit Nohkalikai Falls in Cherrapunji which is world's fourth tallest waterfall alongwith Eco Park, Seven Sister Falls, Mawsmai Cave & Wei Sawdong Waterfall in Cherrapunji. Night stay at Mawdok Valley.



Day 05: Cherrapunji – Nongriat – Shillong

Take ½ hour drive to Tyrna Village from Cherrapunji. Take 1.5 hour walk down to Nongriar Village and 2 hours walk up to double decker root bridge whose path is 3 km long and has 3500 stairs. Visit beautiful and scenic rainbow falls in Nongriar and treck back to Tyrna village and back to Shillong.

Day 06: Shillong - Mawphlang Sacred Forest-Wettest Place On Earth (Mawsynram)

Next day head to Nature's Museum in Meghalaya which is known for diversity of flowering and medicinal plants. The forest is situated in village of Mawphlang which is 68 kms from Shillong. Mawphlang in Meghalaya has the highest rainfall on earth and is known as "Westtest Place on the Earth". Mawjymbuin Caves, Meghalaya is known for giant stalagmite in the form of Shiva Linga. Head back to Shillong.



Day 07 : Shillong – Kaziranga National Park (240 kms / 5 hrs.)

On day 7 enjoy visit to Kaziranga National Park with overnight stay



Day 08: Kaziranga National Park – Guwahati (220 kms / 5 hrs.)

Get up early for elephant safari in Kaziranga National park and explore the beauty of forest. Apart from Rhino other species found are Deer, Swamp Deer, Wild Buffalo and if lucky you can see tigers also. It is also home to pelicans, storks and darters as there are a number of water bodies inside the Park. Procees to Guwahati and enjoy Golden Sunset Cruise on the Brahmaputra.



Day 09: Guwahati sightseeing - Guwahati Airport/Railway Station

On the last day visit Tirupati Balaji Temple of Guwahati and then Nabagraha Temple located in Chitrachal hill in the south eastern part of Guwahati city. State Zoo cum Boatnical Garden in Guawahati alongwith Regional Science Centre is must visit place and then proceed to Airport.
